Resolution of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume), titled "Corporations-Municipal", to repeal and re-enact Section 70 of the Charter of the City of Annapolis for the purpose of increasing the sum of money which the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis may borrow at any time and from time to time, from one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.) to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.), and all matters relating generally.
