## Chapter 38

AN ACT to amend Section 20A-4(a) and (g), title "Statement of Financial Interests to be Filed" of Chapter 20A, title "Financial Disclosure" of the Montgomery County Code 1972, as amended, to require all persons holding or appointed to certain designated offices and positions in the County to file the initial sworn statement of financial interest required by this Chapter on or before October 1, 1976, to require persons holding certain designated elected positions in the County to file the sworn financial disclosure statement required by this Chapter to be filed in 1976 on or before October 1, 1976, and to declare that an emergency exists and that this Act shall take effect on the date it becomes law.
