EACH district, for the purposes of this subtitle, shall bear the name of the subdivision out of which it is created.

(B) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF EROSION PREVENTION WORKS ARE SUPPLEMENTAL TO THE NATURAL RESOURCES ARTICLE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SHORE EROSION CONTROL PROJECTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 176

(House Bill 577)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources Police Officers

FOR the purpose of giving Natural Resources Police Officers discretion in issuance of citations to persons committing a misdemeanor.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 1-205(a) of Article - Natural Resources, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

(a) [Whenever a person is apprehended by] IF a Natural Resources Police officer APPREHENDS A PERSON for violating any law punishable as a misdemeanor the officer
