SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 7-325(c) of Article - Agriculture, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

7-325.

(c) Any person [violating the provisions] WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION of this section shall be dismissed immediately from office.
