Any person[, firm, or corporation, violating] WHO VIOLATES any provision of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor[;] and ON CONVICTION is subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000, or imprisonment not exceeding one year, or both, for [any] EACH violation[, with costs imposed in the discretion of the court].

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 190

(House Bill 851)

AN ACT concerning

Aviation - Airman Certification

FOR the purpose of eliminating the requirement that pilots of aircraft be registered by the State Aviation Administration; and providing that the federal certificate of competence be displayed on the demand of certain persons.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 6-602 of Article 1A - Aviation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed.
