CHAPTER 28

(House Bill 395)

AN ACT concerning

Election Code - Removal

FOR the purpose of providing that election boards shall mail the authorizations which cancel a voter's registration because of a change of address to the State Administrative Board of Election Laws; providing that the State Administrative Board of Election Laws shall forward these cancellation authorizations to the proper local election board; and making style changes.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 3-17(b) (2) of Article 33 - Election Code, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

(b) (2) The [clerk of the] board shall mail all such CANCELLATION authorizations to the [board of the proper county or Baltimore City.] STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS WHICH SHALL FORWARD THEM TO THE PROPER ELECTION BOARD.
