507F.

The County Commissioners of Talbot County are hereby directed, authorized and empowered to make provision by appropriation in their annual levy from year to year for sufficient funds to pay the salaries and expenses hereinbefore provided for and are authorized to reimburse the sheriff, in their sound discretion for actual expenses paid out in the course of [this] HIS official duties and necessarily expended where circumstances did not warrant the obtention of prior approval from the commissioners. The sheriff shall submit to the commissioners an annual budget on or before a date determined by said commissioners.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

(House Bill 1852)

AN ACT concerning

Talbot County - State's Attorney
