SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 7-1(d) of Article 33 - Election Code, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

7-1.

(d) [No person shall join in nominating more than one nominee for each office to be filled; nor shall any person] A PERSON MAY NOT sign more than once for the same nominee for an office.
