CHAPTER 259

(Senate Bill 130)

AN ACT concerning

Boilers and Pressure Vessels - Inspection Certificates

FOR the purpose of exempting the State of Maryland or any [[of its]] agencies of State, county, or municipal government from payment of the fee required for the issuance of an inspection certificate for certain boilers and pressure vessels; and making style changes.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 177(c) of Article 48 - Inspections, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(c) If the report filed pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shows that a boiler or pressure vessel [is found to comply] COMPLIES with the rules and regulations of the Board, the owner or user thereof shall
