THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBTITLE IS TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF PRACTICAL PLUMBING AND GASFITTING TO SAFEGUARD THE PUBLIC AGAINST HAZARDS ARISING FROM UNSAFE OR UNSANITARY PLUMBING AND GASFITTING CONDITIONS.

(A) "PLUMBING" MEANS THE PRACTICE, MATERIALS, AND FIXTURES USED IN THE INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE, EXTENSION, ALTERATION, AND REMOVAL OF ALL PIPING, PLUMBING FIXTURES, PLUMBING APPLIANCES, AND PLUMBING APPURTENANCES CONNECTED TO OR TO BE CONNECTED TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: SANITARY DRAINAGE OR STORM DRAINAGE FACILITIES, VENTING SYSTEM AND THE PUBLIC OR PRIVATE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS WITHIN OR ADJACENT TO ANY BUILDING, STRUCTURE, OR CONVEYANCE. THE TERM INCLUDES THE PRACTICE AND MATERIALS USED IN THE INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE, EXTENSION, ALTERATION, OR REMOVAL OF STORM WATER, REFRIGERATION, AND AIR CONDITIONING DRAINS, LIQUID WASTE OR SEWAGE, AND WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS OF ANY PREMISES, TO THEIR CONNECTION WITH THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM, OR
