WASHINGTON COUNTY THE HOLDER OF ANY LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE IS PERMITTED TO EXERCISE ALL OF THE PRIVILEGES CONFERRED BY THAT LICENSE ON THE DAY OF ANY ELECTION IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 316

(Senate Bill 674)

AN ACT concerning

Education Assistance - Child of Certain National Guardsmen Killed or Disabled
