RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO THE SUITABILITY OR NCNSUITABILITY OF THE PROPOSAL IN RELATION TO THE AIMS OF THE ST. MARY'S CITY COMMISSION, WITH COPIES TO THE BOARD OF FUBLIC WORKS, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES.

NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 78A, §19A, AND SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS AND IN OTHER PROVISIONS OF ACCORDANCE WITH THIS APTICLE REGARDING THE ST. MARY'S CITY COMMISSION, THE SECRETARY ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT MAY ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE NATURE CONSERVANCY FOR THE STATE TO ACQUIRE TITLE TO OR AN INTEREST IN PROPERTY OWNED BY THE NATURE CONSERVANCY OF PROPERTY ON WHICH THE NATURE CONSERVANCY HOLDS AN OPTION OR A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
