

SEVERAL COMMITTEES MAY REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF AUDITS TO EXAMINE AND REPORT ON THE ACCOUNTING RECORDS OF ANY ASSOCIATION OR INCORPORATED INSTITUTIONS MAINTAINED FOR INDUSTRIAL, EDUCATIONAL, MEDICAL, HUMANE, MILITARY, OR CHARITABLE PURPOSES, SECURING ANY APPROPRIATION FROM THE STATE TREASURY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF AN ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.]]

(2) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, BY RESOLUTION, AND THE JOINT BUDGET AND AUDIT COMMITTEE [[OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY]] MAY DIRECT THE DIVISION OF AUDITS TO UNDERTAKE AN EXAMINATION OF AND TO REPORT ON THE ACCOUNTS AND RECORDS OF ANY ASSOCIATION, CORPORATION, OR INCORPORATED INSTITUTION THAT SECURES AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE STATE TREASURY THROUGH THE PROVISIONS OF AN ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

AN ACT concerning

Water and Water Resources
