REFUSES TO COMPLY WITH ANY ORDER ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER SECTION 386E MAY, IN AN ACTION BEOUGHT IN THE APPROPRIATE STATE COURT TO ENFORCE THE ORDER, BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$5,000 FOR EACH DAY IN WHICH THE VIOLATION OCCURS OR FAILURE TO COMPLY CONTINUES.

(D) THE SECRETARY MAY INSTITUTE A CIVIL ACTION IN ANY COURT OF APPROPRIATE JURISDICTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF TO PREVENT VICLATION OF ANY ORDER CR REGULATION ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBTITLE, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDIES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION.

386J.

TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS AND PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY IS AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO:

- (A) PERFORM ANY AND ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES AND REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE RELATING TO THE ADOPTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF STATE PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS.
- (B) ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE AND ALL RULES, REGULATIONS, AND ORDERS PROMULGATED, ISSUED, OR EFFECTIVE HEREUNDER.
- (C) ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS, CONTRACTS, OR COOPERATIVE ARRANGEMENTS, UNDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS APPROPRIATE WITH OTHER STATE, FEDERAL, OR INTERSTATE AGENCIES, MUNICIPALITIES, POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS, EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS, OF OTHER ORGANIZATIONS OR INDIVIDUALS.
- (D) RECEIVE FINANCIAL AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE AGENCIES.
- (E) PARTICIPATE IN RELATED PROGRAMS OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, OTHER STATES, INTERSTATE AGENCIES, OR OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE AGENCIES OR ORGANIZATIONS.
- (F) ESTABLISH ADEQUATE FISCAL CONTROLS AND ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES TO ASSURE PROPER DISBURSEMENT OF AND ACCOUNTING FOR FUNDS APPROPRIATED OR OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR THE PURPOSE OF CAFRYING OUT PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (G) DELEGATE THOSE RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE FOR THE PUPPOSE OF ADMINISTERING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (H) ESTABLISH AND COLLECT FEES FOR CONDUCTING NECESSAPY INSPECTIONS AND LABORATORY ANALYSES.
- (I) PRESCRIBE REGULATIONS THAT ARE NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE TO CARRY OUT HIS FUNCTION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
