21-404.1. VEHICLE ENTERING HIGHWAY FROM CROSSOVER.

THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE ABOUT TO ENTER OR CROSS ANY OTHER PART OF A HIGHWAY FROM A CROSSOVER, WHETHER OR NOT SIGNPOSTED, SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ANY OTHER VEHICLE APPROACHING ON THAT PART OF THE HIGHWAY. THE APPROACH TO AND METHOD OF MAKING A LEFT TURN AT A CROSSOVER SHALL BE MADE AS REQUIRED BY §21-601(B) OF THIS TITLE.

21-405. OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON APPROACH OF EMERGENCY VEHICLES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

ON THE IMMEDIATE APPROACH OF AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE USING AUDIBLE AND VISUAL SIGNALS THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF §22-218 OF THIS ARTICLE OR OF A POLICE VEHICLE LAWFULLY USING AN AUDIBLE SIGNAL, THE DRIVER OF EVERY OTHER VEHICLE, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY A POLICE OFFICER, SHALL:

(1) YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY;

(2) DRIVE IMMEDIATELY TO A POSITION PARALLEL TO AND AS CLOSE AS POSSIBLE TO THE EDGE OR CURB OF THE ROADWAY, CLEAR OF ANY INTERSECTION; AND

(3) STOP AND STAY IN THIS POSITION UNTIL THE EMERGENCY VEHICLE HAS PASSED.

(B) DRIVER OF EMERGENCY VEHICLE NOT RELIEVED FROM DUTY OF CARE.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT:

~~(1) RELIEVE THE DRIVER OF AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE FROM THE DUTY TO DRIVE WITH DUE REGARD FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL PERSONS; OR~~

~~(2) PROTECT THE DRIVER FROM THE CONSEQUENCES OF HIS RECKLESS DISREGARD FOR THE SAFETY OF OTHERS.~~
