21-806. SPECIAL SPEED LIMITATIONS FOR SCHOOL BUSES AND ELEVATED STRUCTURES.

(A) TYPE I SCHOOL VEHICLE (SCHOOL BUS).

A PERSON MAY NOT DRIVE A TYPE I SCHOOL VEHICLE (SCHOOL BUS) AT A SPEED OF MORE THAN 45 MILES AN HOUR WHILE IT IS CARRYING ANY PASSENGER.

- (B) ESTABLISHMENT OF MAXIMUM SAFE SPEED ON BRIDGE OR OTHER ELEVATED STRUCTURE.
- (1) ON REQUEST OF ANY LOCAL AUTHORITY, THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION SHALL INVESTIGATE AND, ON ITS OWN INITIATIVE, IT MAY INVESTIGATE ANY BRIDGE OR OTHER ELEVATED STRUCTURE THAT IS A PART OF A HIGHWAY.
- (2) IF IT DETERMINES THAT THE STRUCTURE CANNOT SAFELY WITHSTAND THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES TRAVELING AT THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY THIS SUBTITLE, THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION SHALL:
- (I) ESTABLISH THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT THAT THE STRUCTURE CAN SAFELY WITHSTAND; AND
- (II) AT EACH APPROACH TO THE STRUCTURE, PLACE OR PERMIT THE PLACEMENT OF A SUITABLE SIGN STATING THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT.
- (3) A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION IS EFFECTIVE WHEN POSTED ON APPROPRIATE SIGNS GIVING NOTICE OF THE LIMIT.
