

(B) TRUCK OR BUS.

IF A TRUCK OR BUS IS TRAVELING ON A DOWNGRADE, THE DRIVER OF THE TRUCK OR BUS MAY NOT COAST WITH THE CLUTCH DISENGAGED.

21-1109. FOLLOWING FIRE APPARATUS PROHIBITED.

UNLESS HE IS ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS, THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE MAY NOT:

(1) FOLLOW WITHIN 500 FEET OF ANY FIRE APPARATUS TRAVELING IN RESPONSE TO A FIRE ALARM; OR

(2) DRIVE OR PARK WITHIN 300 FEET OF ANY FIRE APPARATUS STOPPED IN RESPONSE TO A FIRE ALARM.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66 1/2, §11-1109.

In item (1) of this section, the phrase "traveling in response to ..." is added to conform to the Uniform Vehicle Code counterpart to this section, as well as §21-106 of this subtitle, which grants special privileges to fire apparatus "while ... responding to, but not while returning from, a fire alarm".

The only other changes are in style.

21-1110. CROSSING FIRE HOSE.

UNLESS HE HAS THE CONSENT OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OFFICIAL IN COMMAND, THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE MAY NOT DRIVE OVER ANY UNPROTECTED HOSE OF A FIRE DEPARTMENT THAT IS LAID DOWN ON ANY HIGHWAY OR PRIVATE DRIVEWAY.

21-1111. PUTTING GLASS, INJURIOUS SUBSTANCES, OR REFUSE PROHIBITED.

(A) THROWING OR DEPOSITING CERTAIN INJURIOUS SUBSTANCES.

A PERSON MAY NOT DROP, THROW, OR PLACE ON A HIGHWAY ANY GLASS BOTTLE, GLASS, NAILS, TACKS, WIRE, CANS, OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE LIKELY TO INJURE ANY PERSON,
