

22-409. VEHICLES TRANSPORTING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.

(A) RULES AND REGULATIONS.

THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL ADOPT SUCH REGULATIONS AS ARE NECESSARY FOR THE SAFE TRANSPORTATION OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. THESE REGULATIONS SHALL DUPLICATE OR BE CONSISTENT WITH CURRENT HAZARDOUS MATERIALS REGULATIONS OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

(B) VEHICLES TO COMPLY WITH REGULATIONS.

ANY PERSON DRIVING A VEHICLE CARRYING ANY HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AS CARGO ON A HIGHWAY SHALL COMPLY AT ALL TIMES WITH THIS SECTION AND THE REGULATIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATOR ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

(C) VEHICLES TO BE MARKED OR PLACARDED.

THE VEHICLE SHALL BE MARKED OR PLACARDED AT SUCH PLACES AND IN SUCH MANNER AS ARE REQUIRED BY REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

(D) VEHICLES TO BE EQUIPPED WITH FIRE EXTINGUISHERS.

THE VEHICLE SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH FIRE EXTINGUISHERS OF A TYPE, SIZE, AND NUMBER APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR, FILLED AND READY FOR IMMEDIATE USE, AND PLACED AT A CONVENIENT POINT ON THE VEHICLE.

22-410. AIR CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "AIR CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT" MEANS MECHANICAL VAPOR COMPRESSION REFRIGERATION EQUIPMENT USED TO COOL THE DRIVER'S OR PASSENGER COMPARTMENT OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE.

(B) AIR CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT SHALL BE MANUFACTURED, INSTALLED, AND MAINTAINED WITH DUE REGARD FOR THE SAFETY OF THE OCCUPANTS OF THE VEHICLE AND THE PUBLIC AND MAY NOT CONTAIN ANY REFRIGERANT THAT IS TOXIC TO PERSONS OR IS FLAMMABLE.

(C) THE ADMINISTRATOR MAY ADOPT AND ENFORCE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS, REGULATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR AIR CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
