24-102. WIDTH OF VEHICLES.

(A) HOW WIDTH TO BE MEASURED.

FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE WIDTH OF A VEHICLE INCLUDES ANY LOAD THAT IT CARRIES AND EXCLUDES ANY APPROVED SAFETY EQUIPMENT.

(B) EXCEPTIONS.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY:

(1) FARM EQUIPMENT;

(2) VEHICLE TRANSPORTING FARM EQUIPMENT; OR

(3) VEHICLE CARRYING A LOAD OF FORAGE CROPS IN CONNECTION WITH HARVESTING OPERATIONS, IF THE DISTANCE TRAVELED WITH THE LOAD ON THE HIGHWAYS IN THIS STATE IS LESS THAN 5 MILES.

(C) MAXIMUM WIDTH LIMITS - IN GENERAL.

(1) A VEHICLE MAY NOT BE DRIVEN ON ANY HIGHWAY IF THE WIDTH OF THE VEHICLE EXCEEDS THE LIMITS SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBSECTION, UNLESS:

(I) IT HAS A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION UNDER §24-112 OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR

(II) AS TO A HIGHWAY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF A LOCAL AUTHORITY, IT HAS SPECIAL PERMISSION FROM THE LOCAL AUTHORITY.

(2) FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE LOADED WITH TOBACCO HOGSHEADS OR SOD THE WIDTH LIMIT IS 103 INCHES.

(3) FOR A BUS ON ANY HIGHWAY THAT IS PART OF THE STATE PRIMARY SYSTEM, THE WIDTH LIMIT IS 102 INCHES.

(4) FOR ANY OTHER VEHICLE, THE WIDTH LIMIT IS 96 INCHES.

(D) SAME - EXCEPTION BY MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE FOR BUSES.

BY ORDINANCE, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OR BALTIMORE CITY MAY PERMIT THE OPERATION IN ITS JURISDICTION OF ANY BUS THAT IS NOT OVER 102 INCHES WIDE.
