THIS SECTION WINE MAY BE SOLD AS PROVIDED UNDER A WINERY LICENSE OR A LIMITED WINERY LICENSE IN ANY ELECTION DISTRICT IN FREDERICK COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 37

(Senate Bill 132)

AN ACT concerning

Water Resources - Permits for Water Utilization

FOR the purpose of requiring certain documents to be made public record by a certain time prior to hearing on a permit for utilization of water; and providing an exception to this requirement.

Article - Natural Resources Section 8-805 Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1976 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 8-805 of Article - Natural Resources, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

8-805.

Each application for a permit required by this subtitle shall be accompanied by maps, drawings, and specifications of proposed use or waterway obstruction, changes, additions, or repairs proposed to be made, and other data and information the Department requires. IF A HEARING IS TO BE HELD ON THE APPLICATION, ALL PERTINENT DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE FILED AND MADE A PUBLIC RECORD AT LEAST 15 DAYS PRIOR TO THE
