

CHAPTER 86

(House Bill 882)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - County Commissioners

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the county commissioners of Frederick County; and specifying that the salary alteration for which provision is made by this Act does not affect the incumbents.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 2-4 of the Public Local Laws of Frederick County being Article 11 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1959 Edition as Supplemented to December 1975 and as amended) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 11

2-4.

The county commissioners shall receive an annual salary of [\$12,500] \$16,000 as full compensation for their services as county commissioners or as a member of any other county board or agency. The county commissioners shall in addition receive such sums for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as may be provided in the annual county budget.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act shall not be construed to extend or apply to the salary of the persons specified by this Act in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary of the persons specified by this Act shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
