to be given a person under the Estates and Trusts Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland to conform that requirement with the nomenclature used by United States Postal Service regulations.

(a) Unless personal service or some other method of notice is expressly required in this article or by the Maryland Rules, the first notice required or permitted to be given a person is sufficient if deposited as [registered or certified] RESTRICTED DELIVERY mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the addressee at the address last known to the sender, with delivery restricted to the addressee.

(Senate Bill 277)

THE BUDGET BILL (Fiscal Year 1978)
