CHAPTER 9

(Senate Bill 51)

AN ACT concerning

Foreign Discriminatory Boycott Act - Recodification

FOR the purpose of recodifying the provisions of the Foreign Discriminatory Boycott Act in the Commercial Law Article; and changing certain internal cross-references in these provisions to conform with this recodification.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 11-2A09(a) and (b), 11-2A11, and 11-2A12 of Article - Commercial Law, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Commercial Law

Subtitle [2A] 1. Foreign Discriminatory Boycotts

11-2A09.

(a) (1) The Attorney General shall institute proceedings in equity to prevent or restrain violations of section [11-2A03] 11-103 and may require assistance from any State's attorney for that purpose.
