EACH FULL TIME EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FIRE RESCUE SERVICE SHALL BECOME A MEMBER OF THE BALTIMORE CITY FIRE AND POLICE EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM. THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REIMBURSE THE CITY FOR THE EMPLOYER'S COST OF THE PENSION COVERAGE.
