

(C) THE COMMISSION MAY ENFORCE THIS SECTION BY SUBPOENA.

(D) A PERSON WHO IN GOOD FAITH PROVIDES THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL ACTION FOR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION.

(E) A REPORT MADE UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO SUBPOENA OR DISCOVERY PROCEEDING IN ANY CIVIL ACTION EXCEPT PROCEEDINGS ARISING OUT OF HEARINGS AND DECISIONS OF THE COMMISSION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

(Senate Bill 276)

AN ACT concerning

Clerks of Court - Compensation

FOR the purpose of ~~removing reference to a minimum and maximum annual salary permitted to be paid to the clerks of the circuit court in each county and Baltimore City; permitting the Board of Public Works to determine the annual salary of each clerk of the circuit court of the counties and of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City; providing that from the time the clerk of each county elected in the November election of 1978 commences his term the clerk of each court shall receive such annual salary as set forth by the Board of Public Works, plus cost of living increases; and clarifying language.~~ changing the maximum salary permitted to be paid to the clerks of the circuit court in each county and Baltimore City; providing that this Act applies only to certain clerks of the court; and clarifying language.
