- (3) EVERY VEHICLE SHALL BE LABELED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS REGULATIONS OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
- (H) THE COMPTROLLER MAY CANCEL, SUSPEND, OR REVOKE THE REGISTRATION OF A PETROLEUM TRANSPORTER, OR ANY REGISTRATION OR IDENTIFICATION MARKER GRANTED TO A PETROLEUM TRANSPORTER FOR A CONVEYANCE, FOR FAILURE TO FILE A REPORT REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (E) CR FOR THE FILING OF FALSE INFORMATION IN ANY SUCH REPORT. THE PETROLEUM TRANSPORTER SHALL BE GIVEN NOTICE AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD.
- (I) ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION OR IMPRISONMENT FOR SIX MONTHS OR BCTH.
- 4J) THE COMPTROLLER MAY FROMULGATE SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

(Senate Bill 319)

AN ACT concerning

Deep Mine Operator's License
