(G) ADOPTION OF PROCEDURES.

WITH THE COOPERATION OF THE DISTRICT COURT, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP PROCEDURES TO CARRY OUT THOSE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION THAT RELATE TO THE SUSPENSION OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES.

26-205. NONRESIDENT MOTOR CARRIER CITATION PROGRAM.

(A) DEFINITIONS.

(1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS ANY VEHICLE USED IN THE TAXABLE OPERATIONS OF A MOTOR CARRIER, AS SPECIFIED IN THE ROAD TAX ON MOTOR CARRIERS ACT, ARTICLE 81, §§ 412 ET SEQ. OF THE CODE.

(3) "MOTOR CARRIER" MEANS ANY PERSON SUBJECT TO TAXATION UNDER THE ROAD TAX ON MOTOR CARRIERS ACT, ARTICLE 81, §§ 412 ET. SEQ. OF THE CODE.

(B) APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE.

A NONRESIDENT MOTOR CARRIER THAT OPERATES A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE MAY APPLY IN WRITING TO THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE FOR THE BENEFITS OF SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.

(C) RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(1) THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

(2) THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE:

(I) THE FORM OF APPLICATION TO BE USED UNDER THIS SECTION;

(II) ANY REQUIREMENTS THAT THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO QUALIFY AN APPLICANT FOR THE BENEFITS OF SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION;

(III) STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE APPROVAL, DISAPPROVAL, RENEWAL, SUSPENSION, AND REVOCATION OF APPROVED STATUS UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(IV) THOSE PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW OR OTHER TRAFFIC LAWS OR ORDINANCES FOR WHICH THE BENEFITS OF SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION APPLY.

(D) EFFECT ON DISCRETION OF POLICE OFFICER.
