CHAPTER 188

(Senate Bill 532)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages - Application for License

FOR the purpose of altering the requirements for an application for certain licenses.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

Section 56(5)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 56(5) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

56.

Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, every new application for a license shall be made to the board of license commissioners or the clerks of court upon forms prescribed by the Comptroller and sworn to by the applicant. Every application for a license shall contain the following statements:

(5) The age[.] AND sex [and color] of the applicant;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
