observed by him or reported to him. [No] A person [shall] MAY NOT accept appointment or continue as an inspector if either he or any member of his immediate family has any personal or financial interest either directly or indirectly in any license or in any licensed premises under the provisions of this article. The County Commissioners of Frederick County shall provide the alcoholic beverages inspector an office, a part—time secretary of his own choosing, and an expense account to be determined by the County Commissioners.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act shall not be construed to extend or apply to the salary of the persons specified by this Act in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary of the persons specified by this Act shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION  $\frac{3}{2}$ . AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
