(e) (1) The person for whom special plates are issued under this section OR UNDER A SIMILAR PROVISION OF ANY OTHER STATE:

(i) May park for unlimited periods in parking zones restricted as to the length of parking time permitted; and

(ii) Is not required to pay any parking meter fees of this State or of any political subdivision of this State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

(Senate Bill 669)

AN ACT concerning

The Anatomy Board and the Transportation
of Human Specimens

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Anatomy Board of Maryland, authorizing certain schools to receive human specimens, and providing that certain schools may receive human specimens at their out-of-State facilities.
