

(B) EVERY VETERINARY HOSPITAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD. THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$10. THE LICENSE SHALL BE APPLIED FOR AND ISSUED TO THE OWNER OF THE HOSPITAL.

(C) THE BOARD MAY REJECT AN APPLICATION, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE LICENSE FOR FAILURE TO MAINTAIN THE FACILITY PROPERLY. THE REJECTION, SUSPENSION, OR REVOCATION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES SET OUT IN § 2-311.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 209

(Senate Bill 771)

AN ACT concerning

County Commissioners - Publication of Acts

FOR the purpose of changing the publication and recording requirements of acts, ordinances, and resolutions proposed and adopted by certain county commissioners; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 25 - County Commissioners  
 Section 3(r) and 4(a) and (b)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 3(r) and 4(a) and (b) of Article 25 - County Commissioners, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

(r) [No] AN act, ordinance, or resolution [shall] MAY NOT be adopted by the county commissioners, under the powers conferred by this section, until ten days after a public hearing has been held on the proposed act, ordinance, or resolution.
