measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

SECTION 2 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

## CHAPTER 223

(Senate Bill 912)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages (Salary of Board of License Commissioners)

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the license commissioner in Frederick County; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B — Alcoholic Beverages Section 155(1) Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 155(1) of Article 2B — Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Feverages

155.

(1) In Frederick County the license commissioner shall receive a salary of [twenty-four hundred dollars (\$2,400.00)] \$3,600 per annum.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
