(c)] The budget analysts shall be graduates of a recognized school of business administration with at least three years experience in personnel and other subjects related to the operation of business organizations. [He] THEY shall continuously study and analyze all budget expenditures and make such recommendations to provide a greater degree of efficiency and economy in any State department or institution. The Secretary may prescribe experience equivalents in lieu of the educational requirements listed above. He may prescribe such additional qualifications and duties as he may deem necessary [for the above—named employees].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

The Commission on Artistic Property Membership and Duties
