

PREVIOUSLY BEEN OCCUPIED. HOWEVER, IMMEDIATELY ON OR BEFORE THE DATE OF OCCUPANCY, AND REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE DWELLING IS SOLD, RENTED OR MERELY OCCUPIED, THE APPLICANT FOR A TAX CREDIT SHALL SEND TO THE GOVERNING BODY OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY AN APPROPRIATE NOTICE THAT THE DWELLING HAS BEEN SOLD, RENTED OR OCCUPIED. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL RESULT IN THE IMMEDIATE FORFEITURE OF ALL TAX CREDITS WHICH HAVE BEEN APPLIED TO THE DWELLING UNIT CONCERNED.

(C) THE GOVERNING BODY OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY MAY FURTHER PROVIDE FOR PROCEDURES APPLYING TO THE TAX CREDIT, IN A MANNER NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION.

(D) THE TAX CREDIT FOR WHICH PROVISION IS MADE IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE APPLICABLE TO TAXATION IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY ONLY. THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED OR MAY NOT BE APPLIED TO CHANGE THE NORMAL AND REGULAR ASSESSMENT PROCEDURES WHICH ARE APPLICABLE IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, AND THE CREDIT PROVIDED BY THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY ONLY TO COUNTY TAXES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977. It shall remain effective for a period of two years and, at the end of June 30, 1979, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

AN ACT concerning

Chiropractor - Inactive Status
