(a) Records, reports, statements, notes, or information assembled or obtained by the State Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Maryland Commission to Study Problems of Drug Addiction, the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty or its allied medical societies, an in-hospital staff committee, or a national organized medical society or research group, which are declared confidential by § [1-1] 1-I or § [1-34] 134 of Article 43 of the Code, are not admissible in evidence in any proceeding.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 266

(House Bill 1292)

AN ACT concerning

Tax Sales - Interest Rate for Redemption

WHEREAS, Each of the four bills was enacted without giving effect to the other bills, which has resulted in verboseness in the two sections of the Code affected; and
