## CHAPTER 305

(Senate Bill 239)

AN ACT concerning

Attorneys - Discipline

FOR the purpose of repealing those provisions relating generally to disciplining of attorneys; prohibiting the practice of law by an attorney who is suspended, on inactive status or distarred; providing a penalty therefor; providing a certain period to wind up the affairs of his law practice; prohibiting certain officials from acting as an agent for a lawyer in solicitation of clients from place of criminal punishment; and providing a penalty.
