HEMOPHILIA; OR WHO IS BLIND OR WHOSE VISION IS SUBSTANTIALLY IMPAIRED.

- (B) THE ALTERNATE POLLING PLACE SHALL BE LOCATED IN THE SAME COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY AS THE POLLING PLACE WHERE THE VOTER RESIDES AND MUST SHALL -IF-FOSSIBLE MUST BE ONE IN WHICH THE BALLOT USED IS IDENTICAL TO THE EALLOT IN THE POLLING PLACE WHERE THE VOTER RESIDES.
- (C) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IF A SIRUCTURALLY BARRIER FREE ALTERNATE POLLING PLACE MEETING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) IS AVAILABLE. HOWEVER, WHERE IT-IS-NECESSARY-TO-ACHIEVE-THE-PURPOSES-OF-THIS-SECTION, THE BOARD MAY-PROVIDE FOR THE USE-OF-PAPER BALLOTS-IN-ANY SIRUCTURALLY BARRIER PREE POLITIC PLACE-WHICH—IS AVAILABLE.

CHAPTER 307

(Senate Bill 255)

AN ACT concerning

Driving - Cancelled Out Of State License

FOR the purpose of making it an offense for a person to drive in Maryland if his license has been cancelled, refused, suspended or revoked in Maryland or a license issued by any other State is cancelled, suspended, or revoked; and providing for the admissibility of certified copies of certain records in judicial proceedings.
