SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 461B he and it is hereby added to Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

461B.

(A) IN ANY INDICTMENT OR WARRANT CHARGING RAPE OR A SEXUAL OFFENSE, IT SHALL BE SUFFICIENT TO USE A FORMULA FORM SUBSTANTIALLY TO THE FOLLOWING EFFECT:

"THAT A-B ON THE DAY OF ______, 19 , IN THE COUNTY (CITY) AFORESAID DID UNLAWFULLY ENGAGE IN A RAPE (SEXUAL OFFENSE) IN THE ____DEGREE WITH COMMIT A RAPE OR SEXUAL OFFENSE UPON C-D, IN VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, SECTION (HERE STATE SECTION VIOLATED), OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND; CONTRARY TO THE FORM OF THE ACT OF ASSEMBLY IN SUCH CASE MADE AND PROVIDED AND AGAINST THE PEACE, GOVERNMENT AND DIGNITY OF THE STATE."

(B) IN ANY CASE WHEREIN THIS GENERAL FORM OF INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, OR WARRANT IS USED TO CHARGE A BAPE OR A SEXUAL OFFENSE, THE DEFENDANT SHALL BE ENTITLED TO A BILL OF PARTICULARS SPECIFICALLY SETTING FORTH THE ALLEGATIONS AGAINST HIM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 337

(Senate Bill 662)

AN ACT concerning

Industrialized Buildings

FOR the purpose of changing the definition of industrialized housing -- providing that -- certain building assemblies that do not include -- cleatrical, plumbing, heating, -- wentilating -- and -- other service systems -- qualify as -- industrialized -- housing; -- and
