- (a) (1) The board has the exclusive power to establish and alter the standards of preliminary and professional education and training requirements of applicants for the examination for a license.
- (2) THE BOARD HAS THE EXCLUSIVE POWER TO ESTABLISH AND ALTER THE STANDARDS OF PROFESSIONAL ELUCATION AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS MAY ESTABLISH AN ANNUAL 12-HOUR CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT AS A CONDITION TO ANY LICENSE RENEWAL.
