BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 266A(c) of Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
