

(A) THE EARNINGS OF PRISONERS SHALL BE COLLECTED BY THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION ~~OR~~, THE COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT OR THE WARDEN OF THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL. FROM THESE EARNINGS THE DIVISION OR THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY THE FOLLOWING:

(1) THE COST OF PROVIDING FOOD, LODGING AND CLOTHING BY THE PLACE OF INCARCERATION TO THE STATE OR THE COUNTY;

(2) COURT ORDERED PAYMENTS FOR SUPPORT OF DEPENDENTS; AND

(3) COURT ORDERED PAYMENTS FOR RESTITUTION.

(B) ANY BALANCE REMAINING AFTER THE PAYMENTS AS SET OUT IN SUBSECTION (A) SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE PRISONER'S ACCOUNT AND PAID TO HIM WITHIN 15 DAYS OF HIS RELEASE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

(Senate Bill 957)

AN ACT concerning

Social Services Administration - Rules and Regulations
