SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COPY OF THE SUBPOENA AND PROOF OF SERVICE. FAILURE TO OBEY AN ORDER OF THE COURT SUBJECTS THE PERSON TO THE SAME PENALTIES AS IN THE CASE OF A WITNESS SUBPOENAED BY THE CCURT IN THE TRIAL OF A CIVIL ACTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
