

SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COPY OF THE SUBPOENA AND PROOF OF SERVICE. FAILURE TO OBEY AN ORDER OF THE COURT SUBJECTS THE PERSON TO THE SAME PENALTIES AS IN THE CASE OF A WITNESS SUBPOENAED BY THE COURT IN THE TRIAL OF A CIVIL ACTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

(House Bill 217)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Fuel Inspection Law - Enforcement

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Comptroller to use various testing methods for the analysis of certain fuel products regulated under the Motor Fuel Inspection Law; requiring compliance with such specifications by certain persons; repealing an obsolete notice provision; ~~authorizing the Comptroller to order the halt of any illegal sale or distribution of petroleum products; authorizing the Comptroller to adopt emergency specifications for certain products in an emergency situation; requiring precautions to insure against inferior specifications; authorizing the Comptroller to require the posting of emergency specifications under certain conditions;~~ and clarifying language.
