(I) CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS AND HOLD HEARINGS:

(II) SUBPOENA WITNESSES, EXAMINE PERSONS UNDER OATH, AND RECEIVE EVIDENCE; AND

(III) COMPEL THE PRODUCTION OF RECORDS, ACCOUNTS, BOOKS, PAPERS, AND OTHER ECCUMENTS.

(2) IF ANY PERSON FAILS TO APPEAR TESTIFY. OR FAILS TO ANSWER ANY ORAL CR WRITTEN OUESTION OF PRODUCE ANY DOCUMENT, THE COMPTRCILER MAY APPLY TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PERSON WAS SERVED, OR THE SUPREME BENCH OF FALTIMORE CITY, FOR AN REOUIRING COMPLIANCE. CRDER THE CCMPTROLLER'S APPLICATION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COPY OF THE SUBPOENA AND PROOF OF SERVICE. FAILURE TO OBEY AN ORDER OF THE COURT SUBJECTS THE PERSON TO THE SAME PENALTIES AS IN THE CASE OF A WITNESS SUBPOENAED BY THE COURT IN THE TRIAL OF A CIVIL ACTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
