

(J) "PETROLEUM PRODUCTS" INCLUDES MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL, RESIDUAL OILS NUMBER 4, 5, AND 6, AND ALL GRADES OF JET (TURBO) FUEL.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 400

(House Bill 221)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Fuel Inspection Law - Gasline Additives

FOR the purpose of requiring the submission to the Comptroller of any material, fluid, or substance offered for sale as a substitute or improver of gasoline or special fuels to be used for certain purposes; specifying the data to be submitted; requiring the Comptroller to inspect and authorize such items prior to their sale; requiring the labeling of such items; providing penalties; requiring the seller of any gasoline or special fuel additive to register the additive with the Comptroller; specifying the information to be submitted with the registration; prohibiting additives with lead in certain circumstances; requiring containers of crankcase oil offered for sale to be labeled in a certain manner; and requiring containers of reconditioned lubricants to be labeled as such in a certain manner.
