SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 700(g) be and it is hereby added to Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

700.

(G) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (B), (C), AND (D), WHENEVER A PRISONER IS RECEIVED BY AN INSTITUTION UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION FROM A COUNTY JAIL OR THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL WHERE HE HAS BEEN HELD IN PRE-TRIAL DETENTION, THE PERIOD OF CONFINEMENT FOR DETERMINING THE CREDITS EARNED BY A PRISONER UNDER SUBSECTIONS (B), (C), AND (D) SHALL COMMENCE FROM THE FIRST DAY OF CONFINEMENT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSIONER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
