

prohibiting trucks from using any highway or alley that is not designated or maintained as a part or extension of the State or federal highway system, provided the local authority has designated an adequate alternate route for diverted truck traffic; [or]

(12) Adopting any other traffic regulations as specifically authorized in the Maryland vehicle law; OR

(13) REGULATING TAXI STANDS, INCLUDING TAXI STANDS IN THE MIDDLE OF A BLOCK.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Class B-D Licenses; Class C License)

FOR the purpose of authorizing the issuance in Queen Anne's County of a Class B-D beer, wine, and liquor license allowing retail sales under certain circumstances; generally relating to Class B-D licenses; altering certain requirements in Queen Anne's County of beer, wine, and liquor licenses, Class C (on-sale) Clubs; and clarifying language.
