

- (1) Age of the child;
- (2) Mental and physical condition of the child;
- (3) The child's amenability to treatment in any institution, facility, or program available to delinquents;
- (4) The nature of the offense and the child's alleged participation in it; and
- (5) The public safety.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 491

(House Bill 885)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages

FOR the purpose of eliminating the prohibition on the transfer of a certain alcoholic beverages license in Frederick County; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 19 (f-1/2)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 19 (f-1/2) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(f-1/2) (1) In Frederick County the annual fee for such a license is [fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500)] \$1,500 for a restaurant and [fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500)] \$1,500 for a hotel.
