such streets and public ways by any or all motor vehicles under such circumstances or upon such conditions as it may, from time to time, by ordinance, deem necessary or expedient in the interest of the public. [Any] EXCEPT AS PERMITTED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, ANY such regulation shall not involve any charge of any kind for the use of such street or public way, other than reasonable charges for parking within areas set aside exclusively for that purpose;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

(House Bill 977)

AN ACT concerning
