

(B) (1) A CLASS H BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO KEEP FOR SALE AND SELL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL AT ANY RESTAURANT FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES.

(2) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

(3) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THIS LICENSE IS \$800.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
